MOUNTING YOUR SPOTTER

Your Spotter GPS Navigator can easily be secured to your windshield for optimal viewing while driving. The mounting system consists of the following pieces:

- Adjustable arm with suction cup
- Navigator cradle

NOTE: Stylus is located on the back of the Navigator cradle

ATTACHING THE MOUNT

- Select location for the mount on the windshield that does not obstruct the driver's view or interfere with operation of the vehicle.
- Clean and dry this area to remove any grease or dirt.
- Place the mount's suction cup on the desired location on the windshield; push the locking lever towards the base of the mount. The mount should stick to the surface.

If mount does not stick, make sure the area is clean and dry, then try again.

- Align the tabs on the mount with the slots on the Navigator cradle. Slide together until the cradle is seated firmly.
- Adjust the adjustable arm to the best viewing angle by:
 - Loosening the adjuster dials
 - Moving the corresponding part to the desired position
 - Tightening the adjuster dials

- Insert the Spotter GPS Navigator into the cradle bottom edge first. Once bottom tabs are aligned, push the top of the Spotter back until it engages the top tab of the cradle.
- To remove the Spotter GPS Navigator from the mount, gently push back the tab on the top of the cradle until the top tab disengages. Then gently pull the Spotter forward and out of the cradle.

DETACHING THE MOUNT

- Pull the locking lever away from the base of the mount.
- Grasp the pull tab of the suction cup and gently pull away from the windshield to break suction.



CAUTION!

When using navigational aids it is your sole responsibility to place, secure, and use these aids in a manner that will not cause accidents, personal injury, property damage, or in any manner obstruct your view.

In Minnesota, GPS systems can only be attached to the lower third of your windshield. (Minnesota Statute: 169.71)

CONNECTING THE CAR CHARGER

- Insert the mini-USB end of the charger into the mini-USB port of the Spotter.
- Insert the opposite end of the charger into the car's power port.

Home chargers are available at www.rightwaygps.com.

CONNECTING THE MINI USB CABLE

- Insert the USB end of the cable into an available USB port on your computer.
- Insert the mini-USB end of the cable into the mini-USB port on the Spotter.

PREPARING YOUR SPOTTER

SWITCHING ON AND OFF

- Switch **ON** your Spotter GPS Navigator by holding down the power button for 4 seconds.
- Switch **OFF** your Spotter GPS Navigator by holding down the power button until unit displays '**Powering Off**'.

FIRST-TIME SETUP

FIRST-TIME POSITION FIX

The Spotter GPS Navigator has an integrated GPS receiver. The first time you use the Spotter, the GPS receiver will take up to 10 minutes to determine your position.

SET UP COPILOT

- Tap the **Navigation** button to begin Initial set-up.
- Follow the directions on the following pages to ensure CoPilot is

configured properly.


1. SELECT LANGUAGE

- Tap the desired language from the on-screen text.

2. SELECT A VOICE

- Your Spotter GPS Navigator, Dale Jr. Edition will default to Dale Jr.'s voice.
- If you would like a different voice, tap the desired voice.

NOTE: To hear a sample of the voice you have selected, tap **Test**. Voices with an * will read street names when providing directions. (See page 34 for additional language and voice options.)

- Once selected, tap 

3. SET UNITS OF MEASURE

- Choose desired units of measure by tapping between **English/Imperial** and **Metric**.

4. SET TIME ZONE

- Scroll through the list and highlight the correct time zone. Tap **OK**.

NOTE: Scroll through the list by gently pressing the stylus to the list and do not remove pressure. Then move the stylus up and down to scroll the list. You will get the best results and smoother scrolling by using the stylus, although you can use your finger as well.

5. END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT

- Read the license agreement for CoPilot Software, tap **Accept** or **Decline**.

NOTE: Tapping Decline will take you out of the navigation software. To use the Spotter GPS Navigator, the user must agree to and accept the End User License Agreement.

6. HOW TO SCROLL

- Read the on-screen how to scroll directions and tap



7. WARNING

- Read warning and tap **Accept**.



GPS Signal: GPS signal will be limited or blocked inside buildings, tunnels, and parking garages. To work effectively the Spotter GPS Navigator should be mounted in the supplied windshield mount with a clear line of sight to the sky.

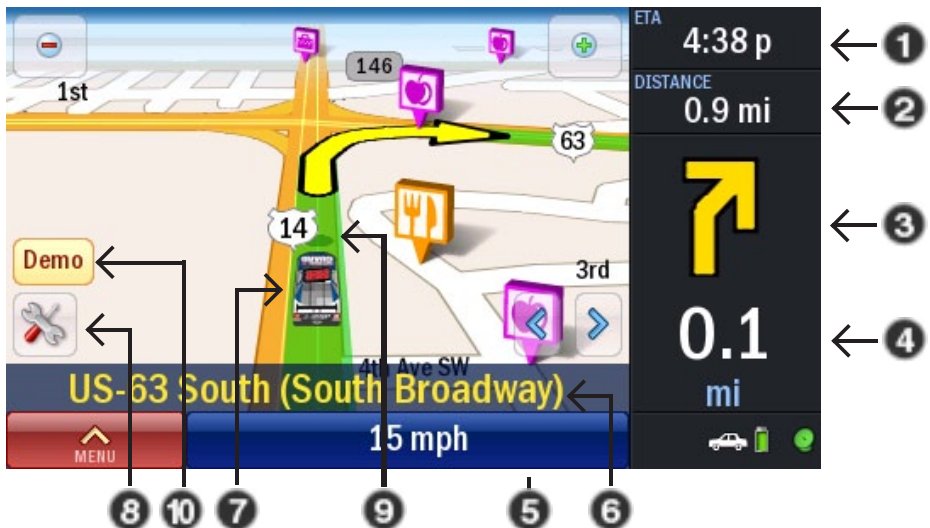

ON SCREEN INFORMATION

The Spotter GPS Navigator will guide you to your destination with spoken directions as well as clear on-screen instructions. Your screen will look similar to the one below. By default your current location is displayed at the bottom of the map. See the Guidance section on page 42 to learn how to modify the information displayed.

DESTINATION

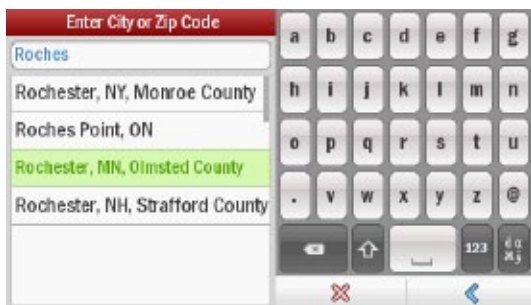
The Spotter GPS Navigator uses GPS satellites to calculate your exact position so you do not need to enter your current location. Simply enter your destination and the Spotter GPS Navigator will provide detailed voice and on-screen instructions to get you there.

ADDRESS

- Tap **Menu > Destination > Address**.
- Enter the city/town name or zip code of your destination.
- Scroll through the list by gently pressing the stylus to the list and do not remove pressure. Then move the stylus up and down to scroll the list. You will get the best results and smoother scrolling by using the stylus, although you can use your finger as well.



- Tap the correct city or area when it appears in the list below the city field.
- Do not enter the house/building number yet.
- Enter the first three or four letters of the street name. Select the correct street name when it appears.



- Enter the house/building number, select it, and tap **GO**.

LOCATE POINTS OF INTEREST



The Spotter GPS Navigator not only guides you to your destination, but also knows all the useful places you might need on your journey.

- Tap **Menu > Destination > Points of Interest**.
- Select the desired search location: **Nearby, In different city, or On my route**:

NEARBY

- Tap **Menu > Destination > Points of Interest > Nearby**.
- Tap desired category. (If category of choice does not appear, tap **More Categories** on the lower right screen to display more options. Or, search by POI name by tapping the lower left **Search by Name** tab.)

For example tap Gas Station for a list of nearby gas stations organized by distance from your location.

- Scroll through the list. Gently press the stylus to the list and do not remove pressure. Then move the stylus up and down to scroll the list. You will get more precise results and smoother scrolling by using the stylus. Once you have found the desired POI, tap the POI to select it.
- A details page will be displayed with POI address and map. Tap **GO**.
- Confirm destination by tapping **GO**.

IN DIFFERENT CITY

- Tap **Menu > Destination > Points of Interest> In a Different City.**
- Enter the city/town name or zip code of your destination.
- Scroll through the list. Gently pressing the stylus to the list and do not remove pressure. Then move the stylus up and down to scroll the list. You will get more precise results and smoother scrolling by using the stylus. Once you have found the desired POI, tap the POI to select it.
- Tap desired category. (If category of choice does not appear, tap **More Categories** on the lower right screen to display more options. Or, search by POI name by tapping the lower left **Search by Name** tab).

For example tap Gas Station for a list of gas stations in the desired city/town organized by distance from the city/town center.

- Scroll through the list of POIs. Note that the distance listed here is measured from the approximate center of the city, not from your current location. Once you've found the desired POI, tap the POI to select it.
- A details page will be displayed with POI address and map. Tap **GO**.
- Confirm destination by tapping **GO**.

ON MY ROUTE

- Tap **Menu > Destination > Points of Interest> On My Route.**
- Tap desired category. (If category of choice does not appear, tap **More Categories** on the lower right screen to display more options. Or, search by POI name by tapping the lower left **Search by Name** tab.)

For example tap Gas Station for a list of gas stations along your route.

- Scroll through the list. Gently press the stylus to the list and do not remove pressure. Then move the stylus up and down to scroll the list. You will get more precise results and smoother scrolling by using the stylus. Once you have found the desired POI, tap the POI to select it.
- A details page will be displayed with POI address and map. Tap **GO**.
- Confirm destination by tapping **GO**.

PICK ON MAP



- Tap on **Menu > Destination > Pick on Map**.
- A map of the area around your current location will be displayed. Drag the screen to move around the map and tap your desired destination when you find it. If needed, use the + and – signs in the upper corners to zoom in and out.
- Confirm destination by tapping **GO**.


INTERSECTION



- Tap on **Menu > Destination > Intersection**.
- Enter the name or zip code of the city on the keypad. Select the destination from the list when it appears.
- Enter the first three or four letters of the first street name. Select the street name from the list when it appears.
- A list of all known intersecting streets will appear. Select the desired cross street from this list.
- Confirm destination by tapping **GO**.

COORDINATES



- Select **Menu > Destination > Coordinates**.
- Select the format of your coordinates: **Degrees Minutes Seconds, Decimal Degrees** or **Decimal Minutes**.
- Enter a latitude and longitude in the selected format. Tap 



The Spotter GPS Navigator will take a few moments to find the point. When the point has been located, a map will appear with the location pinpointed by a red flag.

- Confirm destination by Tapping **GO**.

MY PLACES

Save your home, work, recent and favorite addresses so you don't have to enter them every time.

HOME



- Tap on **Menu > My Places > Home**.
- Enter the city/town name or zip code of your home location.

- Scroll through the list by gently pressing the stylus to the list and do not remove pressure. Then move the stylus up and down to scroll the list. You will get the best results and smoother scrolling by using the stylus, although you can use your finger as well.
- Tap the correct city or area when it appears in the list below the city field.
- Do not enter house/building number; you will enter this on the next step
- Enter the first three or four letters of the street name. Select the correct street name when it appears.
- Enter the house/building number. Select the correct address when it appears.
- Confirm destination by tapping **GO**.

WORK



- Tap on **Menu > My Places > Work**.
- Enter the city/town name or zip code of your work location.
- Scroll through the list by gently pressing the stylus to the list and do not remove pressure. Then move the stylus up and down to scroll the list. You will get the best results and smoother scrolling by using the stylus, although you can use your finger as well.
- Tap the correct city or area when it appears in the list below the city field.
- Do not enter house/building number; you will enter this on the next step.
- Enter the first three or four letters of the street name. Select the correct street name when it appears.
- Enter the house/building number. Select the auto-filled address to continue.
- Confirm destination by tapping **GO**.

RECENT




- Tap on **Menu > My Places > Recent**.
- Scroll through the list and tap the desired recent location.
- Confirm destination by tapping **GO**.

FAVORITES



- Tap on **Menu > My Places > Favorite**.
- Scroll through the list by gently pressing the stylus to the list and do not remove pressure. Then move the stylus up and down to scroll the list. You will get the best results and smoother scrolling by using the stylus, although you can use your finger as well.
- Tap desired location.
- Confirm destination by tapping **GO**.

TO ADD NEW FAVORITE

- Tap on **Menu > My Places > Favorite >** 
- Repeat address entry steps from destination section on page 10.

QUICK STOP




Quick Stop helps you to quickly and easily locate a nearby gas station, restaurant, or hotel. For example, when travelling on a long journey you can use the Quick Stop feature to help you search for a local hotel, find their number, and call them using your phone.

- Tap **Menu > Quick Stop**.

- Tap desired category from quick stop list: Gas Station, Restaurant, Hotel or Vehicle Repair.

- Scroll through the list by gently pressing the stylus to the list and do not remove pressure. Then move the stylus up and down to scroll the list. You will get the best results and smoother scrolling by using the stylus, although you can use your finger as well. Tap the desired quick stop.



- Tap **Show Map** to display all nearby facilities on a map. To return to the facilities list, select **Show List**.
- Tap **Search by Name** to type the name of a facility, and select the one you want when it appears in the list. For example, to look for a specific hotel, begin to type 'Hil' then select 'Hilton' to add this hotel as a destination.
- Tap  to stop searching for facilities.

DETOUR

You can program your Spotter GPS Navigator to make a detour, avoiding part of the calculated route.

ALTERNATE ROUTE

If you are unhappy with the whole route your Spotter GPS Navigator has planned for you:

- Tap **Menu > Detour > Alternate Route**.



The Spotter GPS Navigator will compile a different route if a sensible alternative exists. A map of the proposed detour will be displayed. Tap **Accept** to agree or **Decline** to return to the previous route.

END DETOUR

If you are on a detour route and would like to return to the original trip.



- Tap **Menu** > **Detour** > **End Detour**.

AVOID ROADS

- Tap **Menu** > **Detour** > **Avoid Roads**.
- An itinerary of your trip will appear. Tap on the road you would like to avoid.



The Spotter GPS Navigator will take a few moments to plan an alternate route avoiding the selected road. It will display any change in distance and/or ETA of the new route as well as a map of the new route.

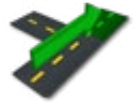


- Tap **Accept** and the Spotter GPS Navigator will begin directing you according to the new route.
- If you decide not to use the new route, tap **Clear** and try another route, or tap **Cancel** to return to your original route.

CLEAR AVOIDED ROADS

The Spotter GPS Navigator will save the details of roads you wish to avoid until you reach your destination. To clear the memory prior to reaching your destination:

- Tap Menu > Detour > Clear Avoided Roads.



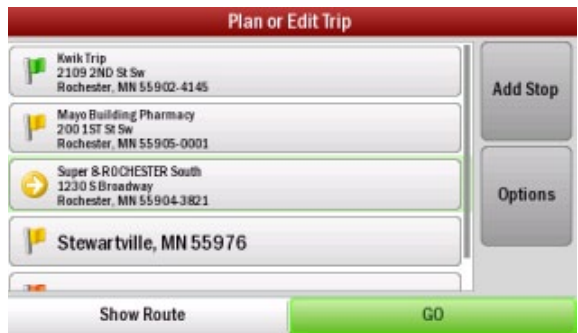
PLAN OR EDIT TRIP

ADD STOP: ENTERING MULTIPLE DESTINATIONS

The Spotter GPS Navigator allows you to plan a trip with up to 50 destinations in one itinerary.

- Tap Menu > Plan or Edit Trip > Add Stop.

- Tap on how you want to enter your destination:
Address, My Places, Points of Interest, GPS Location, Pick on Map, Intersection, Coordinates or Return Trip.



NOTE: Once you have completed your trip, you can use the Spotter GPS Navigator to guide you on your return.

- Add the first destination. (See the Destination section on page 10 for more detailed information.)
- When you return to the Plan or Edit trip screen, repeat these steps to add additional destinations.
- Once all destinations are entered, you may tap **Show Route** to preview your route, **GO** to start driving or customize and save your trip.

EDIT STOP POP-UP MENU

Select a destination on your itinerary and a pop-up menu will appear. This menu is where you can make changes to your itinerary.

CHANGE TRIP ORDER

When you have entered all your destinations you can change the order they appear in your itinerary.

- Tap the address you wish to move. A pop-up menu will appear containing a list of Edit Stop options:



Move to Top



Move to Bottom



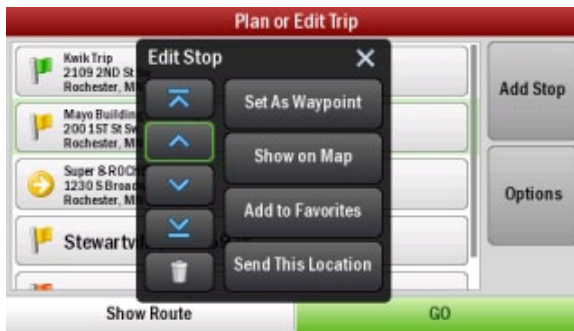
Move Up



Delete



Move Down

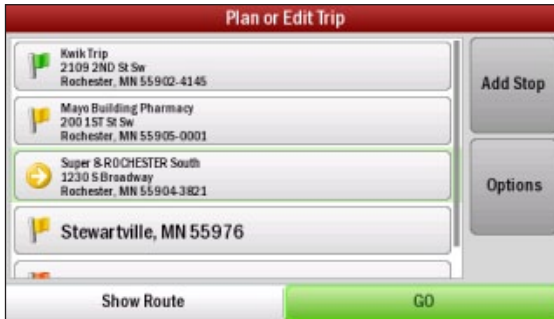


- Tap the desired option. The selected stop will move to its new position in the trip list.

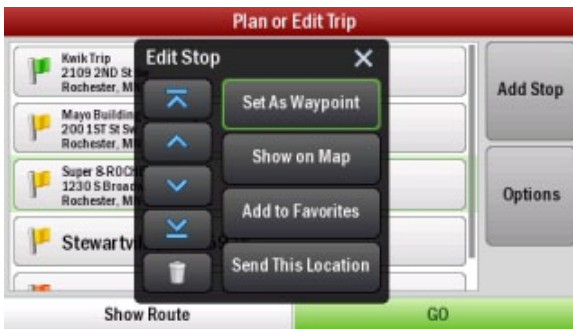
SET AS WAYPOINT

The Spotter GPS Navigator can route you through a certain point without considering it as a stop. By setting Waypoints you can adjust the Spotter GPS Navigator's route to calculate a detour via the waypoint.

- Tap **Menu > Plan or Edit Trip.**
- Enter the waypoint address or destination in the same way detailed in Selecting a Destination starting on page 10.




- The address will appear on the trip list as a stop, with a flag icon next to it.
- Tap the address and a pop-up menu will appear containing a list of options. Tap **Set as Waypoint.**



- The address will now be listed as a Waypoint, with an arrow icon rather than a flag to indicate that it is a Waypoint.

SHOW ON MAP

- From the Plan or Edit Trip screen, select a stop.
- Tap **Show on Map** from the pop-up menu to view a map of the area around the stop.
- Tap  to return to the trip list.

ADD TO FAVORITES

- Tap **Add to Favorites** to save the selected destination to favorites.
- The Spotter will confirm the destination is saved in favorites. Tap **OK**.

SEND TO LOCATION

This feature is not yet available on this model. It was included so your unit would be programmed to accommodate this if and/or when it becomes available.

OPTIONS: CUSTOMIZING YOUR TRIP

SAVE TRIP

When you have finished entering all your destinations, you can save your trip to access at a later date, rather than start driving right away.

- From the Plan or Edit Trip screen, tap **Options > Save**.
- Enter a name for the trip you are saving.
- Tap **OK** and your trip will be saved.

LOAD SAVED TRIP

- From the Plan or Edit Trip screen, tap **Options > Load**.
- Select the trip that you would like to load from the list, then tap **Open**.
- The trip will appear on the Plan or Edit Trip screen where you can choose to **Add Stops, Show Route** or **GO**.

CLEAR A PLANNED TRIP

The Clear option will clear the currently planned trip. It does **NOT** delete saved trips.

- From the Plan or Edit Trip screen, tap **Options > Clear**.
- A Warning - Are you sure? pop-up will appear. Select **Yes** to continue clearing the current trip.
- You will be returned to a blank itinerary on the Plan or Edit Trip screen.

SHOW ROUTE

- From the Plan or Edit Trip screen, tap **Show Route**.
- Select the routing type: **Quickest, Shortest, Avoid Expressways** or **Economic**.
- Use the up and down arrows to indicate your preference for Toll Roads.
- Check the box next to “Don’t show this message again” if you do not wish to select routing type each time you plan a trip.
- When all selections have been made, tap **OK**.
- The Route screen will appear. Tap **Preview** to view your route, **Options** to change routing type, **Edit** to make changes to the route, or **GO** to start driving.

DELETE SAVED PLANNED TRIP

The Delete option will permanently remove a planned trip from the Spotter's database.

NOTE: You will **NOT** be asked to confirm this selection.

- From the Plan or Edit Trip screen, tap **Options > Load**.
- Select the trip that you would like to delete from the list, then tap **Delete**.

OPTIMIZE STOPS



The Spotter GPS Navigator has an Optimize Stops function which will automatically re-order the stops within a trip to create the most efficient route. When you have planned a trip with more than 3 stops:

- From the plan or edit trip screen, tap **Options > Optimize Stops**.
The Spotter GPS Navigator will take a few seconds to reorder your stops for the most efficient journey.

NOTE: Your starting point and final destination will not be altered. However, if you want the final destination to be included in the optimization, select **Options > Take Breaks > check Optimize Final Destination**.

FUEL COSTS ESTIMATE

The Spotter GPS Navigator has the ability to estimate fuel costs for a trip.

- From the Plan or Edit Trip screen, tap **Options > Fuel Cost > check Show Estimated Fuel Cost**.
- Enter the average miles per gallon (average MPG) for your car.
- Enter average cost per gallon.
- Use the   keys to select the currency, then tap **OK**.



TAKE BREAKS

The Spotter GPS Navigator can alert you to take a break at regular intervals during a trip.

- From the Plan or Edit Trip screen, tap **Options** > **Take Breaks** > check **Take breaks during trip**.
- **Break Every**: Select how often you would like to take a break using the up and down arrows.
- **Break For**: Select the length of your breaks using the up and down arrows.
- Tap **OK**.

DRIVING VIEWS

The Spotter GPS Navigator can be customized to meet your individual needs and style. You can choose from six different driving views. To access:

- Tap **Menu** >  > **Driving Views** to choose from all six views or tap the  (driving views shortcut button) to quickly access four of the six views.

3D VIEW

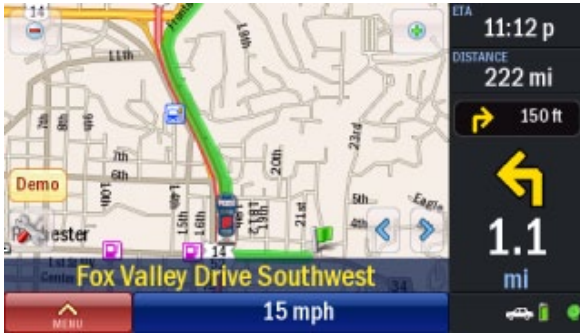
The 3D view displays your current position, next turn and surrounding roads using a bird's eye view.



2D VIEW



The 2D view displays your current position as if you were directly overhead. You may use this view to see more of your surrounding area than with the 3D view.



DRIVER SAFETY



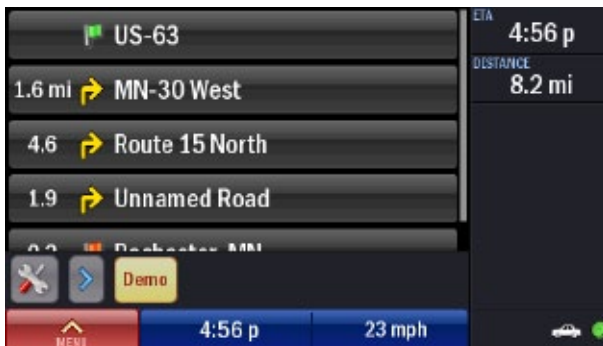
The Driver Safety view displays a turn instruction arrow with concise next turn instructions in large type. In driver safety mode, a map is only displayed as you approach a turn or are traveling below 10 mph. We recommend you choose Driver Safety.



ITINERARY



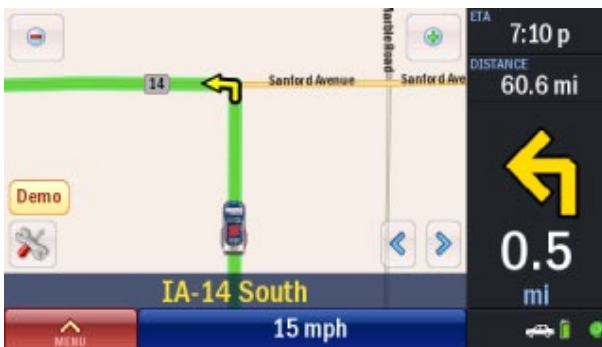
The Itinerary view shows each direction and turn in a written list, including distances.



THE 2D NEXT TURN



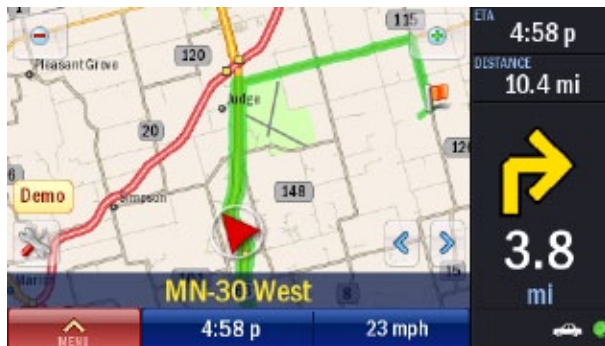
The 2D Next Turn view displays your current location and auto zooms into the next turn on a 2D map.



2D DESTINATION



The 2D Destination view displays your current location and auto zooms into the destination on a 2D map.



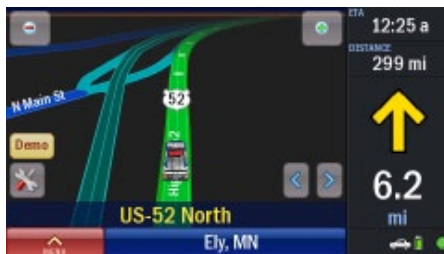
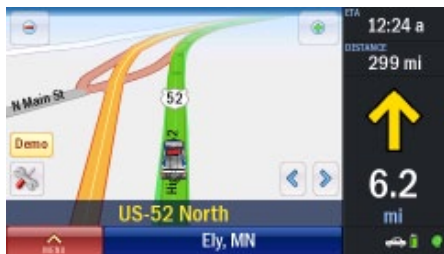
DAY MAP/NIGHT MAP



Lets you choose between a regular map for daytime driving and a map with a dark background that reduces glare for easier nighttime viewing.



NOTE: Overrides automatic day/night mode. If you choose Day Map or Night Map from the Driving Views menu, please see the **Day/Night Mode** section on Page 35 to turn automatic switching back on.




SETTINGS

The Spotter GPS Navigator can be customized to meet your individual needs and style.




ROUTING








You can set up your routing preferences to best suit you.

- Tap **Menu** >  > **Settings** > **Routing**.
- Tap one of the New Routing Profile options: **Automobile**, **Motorcycle**, **Bicycle**, **Walking** or **RV**.

When option is selected, tap 

- Use the   keys to indicate your road preferences (**strongly avoid**, **avoid**, **neutral**, **favor**, **strongly favor**) and speed for **Freeways**, **Divided Highways**, **Primary Roads**, **Secondary Roads**, and **Local Streets**. When finished, tap 


NOTE: Adjusting these values can have a severe effects on the choice of route the Spotter GPS Navigator makes for you. If you're not sure, leave the values at default.

- Select your preference for Toll Roads: **Always Avoid**, **Avoid if Possible**, or **Use**. When option is selected, tap 
- Select routing preferences by checking or unchecking **Avoid Ferries**, **Scenic Route**, **Avoid Propane-Restricted Tunnels**, and/or **International Borders Open**. When options are selected, tap 
- Select **Quickest**, **Shortest**, **Avoid Expressways** or **Economic** routing type and tap 
- Save profile - This step is **OPTIONAL** - To save profile enter a profile name and tap . Or, skip step and tap  to continue.

MAP STYLES



Spotter GPS Navigator offers a range of map styles to select from.

- Tap **Menu** >  > **Settings** > **Map Styles**.

To set a map style for the daytime, use the **Day** map style by toggling the up and down arrows.

To set a map style for the nighttime, use the **Night** map style by toggling the up and down arrows.



The Spotter GPS Navigator will automatically switch between the day and night map styles you have selected when it starts to get light or dark outside.

NOTE: If you have chosen Day Map or Night Map from the Driving Views menu, please see the **Day/Night Mode** section on Page 35 to turn automatic switching back on.

MAP DISPLAY




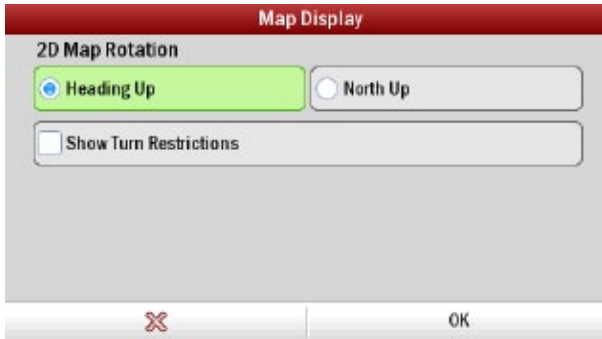
The Spotter GPS Navigator has three map display options:

- **Heading Up:** you will always be travelling upwards on the screen

- **North Up:** holds the map static as you travel along your route.
- **Show Turn Restrictions:** choose to display turn restrictions by checking or un-checking the box.

To adjust the map display to your preference:


- Tap **Menu** >  > **Settings** > **Map Display**.
- Select either **Heading Up** or **North Up** for your map orientation.



- Indicate your preference for Show Turn Restrictions by checking or unchecking the box.
- Tap **OK** to apply the settings and return to the Settings menu.

GPS POINTER

You may change what picture represents you on the map.

- Tap **Menu** >  > **Settings** > **GPS Pointer**.
- Choose which pointer you would like to use.
- Tap **OK** to apply the setting and return to the Settings menu.

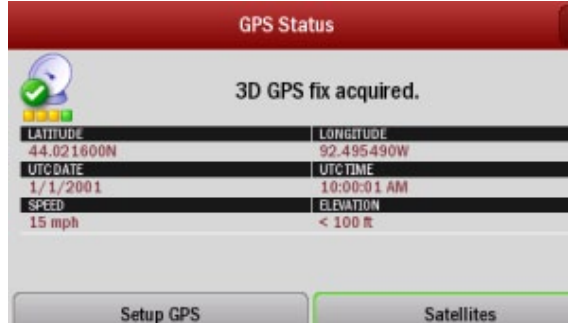
GPS



To check the GPS Status:

- Tap **Menu** >  > **Settings** > **GPS**.

The GPS Status screen shows detailed information regarding the GPS fix and signal strength which your Spotter GPS Navigator uses for guidance. From this screen you can see your current latitude or longitude position in decimal degree format, the UTC time and date, your speed and your elevation.



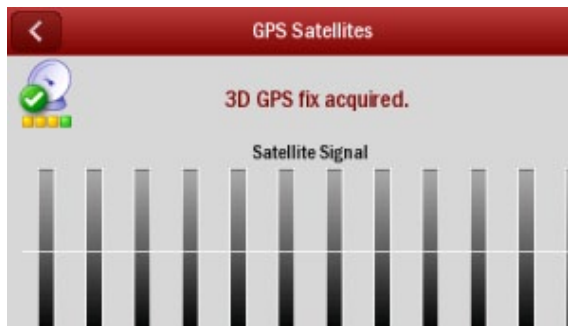
DO NOT USE the GPS Setup menu without direction from Technical Support. The Spotter GPS Navigator is ready out of the box and does not require GPS setup. Changing options in GPS Setup without direction from Technical Support may compromise the Spotter's ability to receive GPS signals.

To check the GPS Satellites:

- Tap **Menu** >  > **Settings** > **GPS** > **Satellites**.

The GPS Satellites screen displays satellite signal strength and the type of GPS fix acquired.



NOTE: Your GPS signal will be limited or blocked when the receiver is inside buildings, tunnels, or garages. To work effectively the GPS receiver needs to have a clear line of sight to the sky.



POI DISPLAY







You may choose which POIs to display on the map and how you would like them displayed.

- Tap **Menu** >  > **Settings** >  > **POI Display**.
- Tap box to choose to show POIs **Always**, **Never**, or **When Stopped**.
- To see or change which POI categories should be shown on the map, select **Currently Displayed POIs**.

TURN WARNINGS



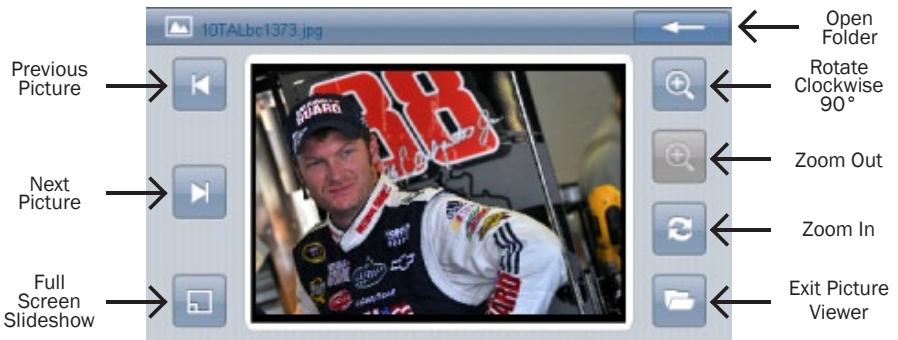
VIEWING BONUS CONTENT

MULTI-MEDIA FEATURES

You may use your Spotter to view videos and pictures stored on a standard memory card. These cards may be purchased at most electronics stores. To save pictures or video to your card, please consult the directions that came with your card.

INSERTING AN SD CARD

- Locate the notched end of your SD card. This end goes in first.
- Locate the SD slot on the right side of the Spotter.
- Insert the SD card gently, notched end first and with the metal connectors toward the front face of the Spotter. Slide the card in until it locks into place.

When the card is locked in place, it will be even with the right edge of the Spotter. Memory cards work best if the metal contacts are clean and undamaged.

VIEWING PICTURES

You may use the Spotter to view pictures in **BMP**, **JPG**, and **GIF** format.

- Load the pictures onto an SD card.
- Insert the SD card into the Spotter.
- Press the **Pictures** button on the main menu to load the picture viewer.
- You will see a list of your pictures, with filenames and thumbnail views of the pictures. If necessary, use the arrows on the right side to scroll up and down the list of pictures.
- Tap directly on a picture to load it.

VIEWING VIDEO

You may use the Spotter to view videos in **MP4, 3GP, WMV, AVI, and DIVX format.**

- Load the videos onto an SD card.
- Insert the SD card into the Spotter.
- Press the **Videos** button on the main menu to load the picture viewer.
- You will see a list of your videos, with filenames and thumbnail views of the videos. If necessary, use the arrows on the right side to scroll up and down the list of videos.
- Tap directly on a video to load it.

SETTINGS MENU

The Spotter GPS Navigator can be customized to meet your individual needs and style.

LANGUAGE

Click on the national flag corresponding to the desired language. The system will automatically save and return to the menu.

BACKLIGHT

The backlight feature enables you to adjust the brightness of the screen and designate the length of time to wait before shutting down the backlight. Once the backlight has gone off, you may tap the screen to restore it.

POWER

The Power button allows you to see the battery status and adjust the length of the stand-by time to meet your needs.

SOUND

Sound allows you to adjust the volume of the unit as well as the screen sound made when a button is tapped.

TIME

The Time button enables you to modify the date, the time, and select your time zone.

SYSTEM

The System button enables you to view information specific to your unit, such as available memory, and to re-calibrate the touch screen.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

WHY WON'T MY UNIT TURN ON?

Check the power. Does the battery need to be charged? Plug into a power source and then try to turn on the device. Make sure to hold the power button for 4 seconds when powering on.

WHY AM I UNABLE TO GET A GPS SIGNAL OR FIX?

The very first time you use the Spotter GPS navigator, it can take up to 10 minutes to initialize the GPS. After the first time, GPS reception should start within 1 minute of turning on the device. If the navigation device has been switched off for more than 1 week, the next initialization can take up to 5 minutes. For the GPS to properly receive satellite data it needs a clear view of the sky. The most common limitations to receiving GPS signals are urban canyons, tunnels and metallic surfaces. Most of the time, this isn't an issue. If you are experiencing difficulty, place your unit near the rearview mirror.

WHY DOES MY UNIT SOMETIMES MAKE A POPPING OR STATIC LIKE NOISE?

The popping/static noise comes from interference with cell phones. It doesn't impact the unit or its performance. If the occasional noise is bothersome, either turn the cell phone off or move the unit further away from the phone.

ALTHOUGH I AM RECEIVING TURN-BY-TURN INSTRUCTIONS ON SCREEN, IT IS NOT SPEAKING TO ME. WHY IS THAT?

Check that the volume on your GPS is turned up. Go to **Menu > Settings > Sound**. If the volume is okay, check **Settings > Language & Voice** to verify your voice selected is a full-text voice. This is noted by an * next to the voice name.

WHY DOES MY UNIT SOMETIMES MISS ANNOUNCING THE STREET NAME?

You can change the turn warning by going to **Settings > Guidance > Choose when you want the device to speak the turn**. Also check **Settings > Language & Voice** to verify your voice selected is a full-text voice. This is noted by an * next to the voice name.

MY DEVICE PROVIDED ME A ROUTE THAT WAS DIFFERENT THAN THE ONE I WOULD ORDINARILY EXPECT THE SYSTEM TO SELECT. WHY?

GPS navigators rely on the quality of navigation software and maps, and the complex interaction between them. The Route Profile setting determines the routing. The Quickest Route setting relies on fast roads such as interstates and highways. This is not necessarily the shortest route. The Shortest Route setting relies on the shortest distance between two points, which may or may not be the fastest.
